O R D E R

On January 7, 1971, Grace Weiershauser, John Weiershauser and Tom Weiershauser submitted affidavits that they are the owners of certain water rights and the lands to which the water rights are appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water rights and request the same be canceled.


The water rights in question are: (a) a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 17233, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Norman C. Workman, for the storage of water from Golden Creek, with a date of priority of August 26, 1940, in a reservoir in Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 9 West, W.M., for irrigation; and (b) a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 17234, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Norman C. Workman, for the use of not to exceed 0.122cubic feet per second of water from Golden Creek and the reservoir constructed under permit No. R-754, with a date of priority of August 26, 1940, for irrigation of 9.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 0.6 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.2 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, all as projected within Edw. Spicer D.L.C. No. 39, in Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 9 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water rights, being portions of the rights described by the certificate recorded at pages 17233 and 17234, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificates of water right are canceled, and in lieu thereof new certificates be issued to describe the balance of the water rights NOT involved in this proceeding.
