## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On July 1, 2011, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the temporary changes proposed in Transfer Application T-11251. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 84, Pages 633-636.
- 2. Under the order, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2015 irrigation season.
- 3. The applicant requested Transfer Application T-11251 be terminated early.

#### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Temporary Transfer T-11251 is terminated and of no further force or effect.
- 2. The use shall revert to the place of use authorized under Certificate 33245.
