ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3292

On August 12, 1975, an application, now in the names of Mr. and Mrs. Bascum T. Page, was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of changes in use theretofore made of water from a spring and place of use of water from Little River, purusant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 31850, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of J. B. Forsythe, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second from a spring for one family domestic use and 0.03 cubic foot per second from Little River for irrigation of a certain 2.6 acres, all within the  $NE^{1}_{4}$   $SW^{1}_{4}$  of Section 2, Township 27 South, Range 3 West, W.M., and all with a priority date of July 9, 1959.

The said spring is located 2060 feet North and 420 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 2; and the point of diversion from Little River is located 2090 feet North and 840 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 2, both points of diversion being within the  $NE^{1}_{4}$   $SW^{1}_{4}$  of said Section 2.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change from the use heretofore made of water from the spring to hereafter use the water for stock water within the  $NE_4^1$   $SW_4^1$  of said Section 2; and to change the place of use of water from Little River from the lands described above to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain other 2.6 acres in  $NE_4^1$   $SW_4^1$  of said Section 2; all without loss of priority.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540,520(2), was published in The News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 9, 16 and 23, 1978.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in use and place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in use heretofore made of water from a spring and place of use of water from Little River, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 31850, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
