O R D E R

On August 29, 1975, Douglas R. Hadley submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in certificate of registration recorded at page GR 1971, Volume 9, Ground Water Registration Record; that he has abandoned said claim of water right and request the same be canceled.


That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 168 gallons per minute of water from well #2 located 625 feet North and 900 feet East from the Southeast corner of Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 4 West, W.M., being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 4 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 13.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

That part of the claimed right described in said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 557 gallons per minute of water from well #2 for the irrigation of 28.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 6.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, 6.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 3.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12, Township 9 South, Range 4 West, W.M., is not in question in this proceeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the claim of a water right for the use of not to exceed 168 gallons per minute of water from well #2 located 625 feet North and 900 feet East from the Southeast corner of Section 1, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 4

West, W.M., for the irrigation of 13.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 4 West, W.M., described in certificate of registration recorded at Page 1971, Volume 9, Ground Water Registration, is canceled.
