## BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR OF OREGON Coos County

IN THE MATTER OF CANCELLATION OF A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT IN THE NAMES OF ALTON AND LESTER K. CLAUSEN AND WILLIAM A. CHURCH )

ORDER

On December 27, 1977, Fred Guerin submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and has authorized cancellation of same.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 12140, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Alton and Lester K. Clausen and William A. Church, and is for the use of water from three springs, with a date of priority of June 2, 1936, for domestic use in Lot 6 of Section 29, Township 27 South, Range 13 West, W. M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 12140, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
