ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6752 submitted by

CITY OF WILLAMINA
411 NE "C"
WILLAMINA, OREGON 97396.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 14501, was perfected under Permit 14420 with a date of priority of JUNE 10, 1940. The right allows the use of WILLAMINA CREEK, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE . This right is limited to 0.45 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN LAMSON DLC 38, SECTION 1, T 6 S, R 7 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 41795 with a date of priority of JUNE 13, 1941. The right allows the use of WILLAMINA CREEK, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER, for MUNICIPAL USE. This right is limited to 0.70 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN LAMSON DLC 38, SECTION 1, T 6 S, R 7 W. W.M.; 970 FEET SOUTH AND 1240 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is within the City of Willamina service area.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 36, T 5 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 950 FEET NORTH AND 1340 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 1.

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THIS CHANGE TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificates 14501 and 41795 are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
