**Findings of Fact**

1. On June 1, 2018, the Department issued an order approving Transfer T-12931. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 108, Pages 425-431.

The order contained a scrivener's error in Condition No. 10 describing the water use measurement conditions. The order described: "**Before water use may begin** under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion (new and existing)."

2. The correct measurement condition should read: "**Before water use may begin** under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at the new point of diversion."

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The order approving T-12931, as recorded in Special Order Volume 108, Pages 425-431 is corrected to describe the measurement condition.
2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 108, Pages 425-431 remain in effect.
