The Santiam Water Control District, successor in interst to the Willamette Valley Water Company and owner of the inchoate water right allowed under Proof No. 145 (Fatjo Right) by decree of the court in the North Santiam River adjudication proceedings and owner of water right permits issued by the State Engineer and designated as Permits E-81 and 1401, has filed with the Water Resources Director an application for a further extension of time in which to complete construction and make complete application of water under said water rights.

The Water Resources Director is authorized under the provisions of ORS 537.230 and 539.010 (5) to grant extensions of time, for good cause shown, within which to complete work or perfect a right under a water right permit or to complete an inchoate right allowed by court decree in an adjudication proceeding.

It appears from the application and supporting data that such reasonable diligence has been shown as entitles the Santiam Water Control District to a further extension of time.

No protest or objection has been filed against the granting of said extensions.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time within which to complete construction work and make complete application of water to beneficial use under Permits E-81 and 1401 and to complete the inchoate water right allowed under Proof No. 145 (Fatjo Right) in the North Santiam River adjudication are extended to October 1, 1977.
