

6. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

Conclusions of Law


The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13352 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13352 is approved.
2. Permit G-18474 in the name of AVION WATER CO., is issued to replace Permit G-17551, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-17551, in the name of AVION WATER CO., is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation (China Hat 3 Well), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation (Brown 1 Well, Brown 2 Well and Dyer 2 Well) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Brown 1 Well, Brown 2 Well and Dyer 2 Well).
4. Measurement, Recording and Reporting Conditions:
 - A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a totalizing flow meter at each new point of appropriation. The permittee shall maintain the device(s) in good working order.
 - B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the device; provided however, where any device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
 - C. The permittee shall keep a complete record of the volume of water diverted each month, and shall submit a report which includes water-use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
 - D. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring and reporting procedures for review and approval
5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this permit.

6. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18474 remain the same.
