O R D E R  
EXTENDING TIME LIMITS

The City of Astoria is the holder of permit No. R-2568 which grants a right to construct Young's Reservoir and storage therein of 12,000 acre feet, and permit No. 27092 which grants a right to the use of not to exceed 26.0 cubic feet per second of water from Young's River and the reservoir for municipal use.

The time for beginning of construction under the permits expired February 15, 1965.

The City has advised the State Engineer that it has reviewed the dependable flow of the stream, storage data, availability of materials and has spent approximately \$30,000 on such studies. The appropriation has not been made because funds are not available and more studies are necessary. The City has submitted an application for a federal loan for this purpose, and desires to preserve the right for this development.

It is considered by the State Engineer that the preservation of the right in question is consistent with the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits for beginning and completion of construction under permits numbered R-2568 and 27092 and the time limit for complete application of water under permit No. 27092 be and the same hereby are extended to October 1, 1969.
