Authority

ORS 537.610, 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which the holder of a certificate of registration may submit a request for recognition of modifications to the place of use, character of use or point of appropriation under a ground water certificate of registration.

OAR Chapter 690, Divisions 382 and 380 implement the statutes and provide the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating ground water registration modification applications.

Findings of Fact

Background

1. On March 29, 2010, Paul Zehr filed a Ground Water Registration Modification Application to modify the point of appropriation and to modify the place of use under Registration Application GR-1137 (Certificate of Registration GR-1097). The Department assigned the application number T-11046.
2. Notice of the Application for Ground Water Registration Modification was published on April 6, 2010, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0600. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On November 23, 2011, the Department mailed a copy of a draft Preliminary Determination proposing to deny Ground Water Registration Modification Application T-11046 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of January 23, 2012, for the applicant to respond. On February 21, 2012, the Department received a request from the applicant to place the transfer on "administrative" hold for additional time to resolve concerns over enlargement and layered water rights.
4. On February 13, 2013, the applicant submitted a revised application and map.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

5. On June 18, 2013, the Department sent out a revised draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant. The revised draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of July 18, 2013, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
6. On August 14, 2013, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Ground Water Registration Modification Application T-11046 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the Ground Water Registration Modification Application was published on the Department's weekly notice on September 3, 2013, and in the Union Bulletin newspaper on September 1, 2013, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
7. The portion of the Ground Water Registration to be modified is as follows:

8. Ground Water Registration Modification Application T-11046 proposes to modify the place of use to:

9. Ground Water Registration Modification Application T-11046 also proposes to modify the point of appropriations approximately 4000 feet southeast to two existing wells located:

10. This Ground Water Registration Modification Application is being processed simultaneously with Transfer Application T-11539, to transfer the primary water right on the "FROM" lands described above in Finding of Fact #7 and, to avoid a layered situation with an existing water right on the proposed "TO" lands.

Review Criteria for Ground Water Registration Modification Applications [OAR 690-382-0700(2)]

11. The Department has determined that the proposed wells will develop the same source of water as the authorized existing well (UMAT 5008).
12. The proposed modifications, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the ground water registration.
13. The proposed modifications, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other water rights.
14. The proposed modifications would not result in a state Scenic Waterway not receiving previously available water during periods in which streamflows are less than the quantities determined by the Department to be necessary to meet the requirements of ORS 390.835.


Conclusions of Law

The modifications in point of appropriation and in place of use proposed in Ground Water Registration Modification T-11046 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.610, 537.705, 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-382-0200 and OAR 690-382-1000 and are approved.

1. The modifications to Registration Application GR-1137 (Certificate of Registration GR-1097) proposed in Ground Water Registration Modification Application T-11046 are recognized. Recognition of the modifications shall not be construed as a final determination of the right to appropriate ground water under the certificate of registration or modification. Such a determination will occur in an adjudication proceeding under ORS 537.670 to 537.695.
2. The use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Registration Application GR-1137 (Certificate of Registration GR-1097) and any related decree.
3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
4. Water shall no longer be appropriated from the original points of appropriation for this portion of the ground water certificate of registration.
5. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
6. The former place of use of the modified ground water registration shall no longer receive water as part of the ground water certificate of registration.

7. Prior to water use at the proposed place of use, the water user shall install and maintain a totalizing flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
8. The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of appropriation. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.
