**ORDER**

**STATEMENT**

On December 23, 2020, the Water Resources Department received a request from the City of Albany (City) to combine the inchoate portion of transfer T-11362 and remaining right certificate 88550, that portion of originating certificate 86470, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Department entered June 26, 2013, approving Transfer Application T-11362, into a new single certificate.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

The final order of the Water Resources Department entered June 26, 2013, approving Transfer Application T-11362, included Item 13 providing that the Department may consider the issuance of a new single certificate confirming the portion of the right transferred and combining it with the remaining right Certificate 88550 issued June 26, 2013.

Satisfactory proof of beneficial use consistent with the terms of the June 26, 2013 order was received by the Water Resources Department on December 23, 2020 addressing the approved changes described in the June 26, 2013 order approving Transfer Application T-11362.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OR  
RECONSIDERATION**

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.482 and ORS 536.075. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

## ORDER

The Department has determined that full beneficial use of the water has been made, consistent with the order of the Water Resources Department entered June 26, 2013, approving Transfer Application T-11362.

The Department shall issue a new single certificate confirming the portion of the right transferred and combining it with remaining right Certificate 88550.

Certificate 88550 is therefore cancelled.
