O R D E R

On August 14, 1964, H. E. and Grace Thornton filed their sworn statement asserting that they are the legal owners of a part of a certain water right and the real property to which said part is appurtenant, that they have abandoned any and all interest in said portion of the water right and request that same be canceled.

The water right in question is a part of that evidenced by the certificate recorded in Volume 9, page 9264, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of 0.043 cubic foot per second of the waters of North Fork of Coquille River, with a date of priority of August 15, 1930, for the irrigation of 3.43 acres in Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M., appurtenant to the tract of land described as follows:


Beginning at an iron rod post which is 1,357.8 feet west and 654.6 feet north 01° west from the southeast corner of said Section 4; thence north 87° 23' west 845.5 feet; thence north 03° 40' east 223.3 feet; thence south 87° 12' east 827.4 feet; thence along the west boundary of the county road south 01° east 221.5 feet to the place of beginning.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of 0.267 cubic foot per second of the waters of North Fork of Coquille River for the irrigation of 18.57 acres in Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, and 3.0 acres in Lot 12 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 3, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M., is not in question.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

use of 0.043 cubic foot per second of the waters of North Fork of Coquille River appurtenant to 3.43 acres in Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 15, 1930, is canceled.
