## O R D E R

APPROVING APPLICATION

On May 10, 1935, Geo. W. Herriott, J. B. Herriott and Tom Herriott filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Big Applegate River.

The applicants herein have a right to the use of 0.8 second foot of the waters of Big Applegate River for the irrigation of 6.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ , 9.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ , 14 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$  and 2.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ , Section 22; 12 acres in SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and 22 acres in NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ , Section 23, all in Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W. M., with date of priority of March 25, 1918, through the Fowler-Offenbacher Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ , Section 33, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

It is proposed to change the point of diversion from the Fowler-Offenbacher Ditch to the head of the Fowler-Keeler, or Kubli Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being within the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Notice for publication as provided by Section 47-712, Oregon Code 1930, was published in the Medford Mail Tribune for a period of three successive and consecutive weeks, in the issues of June 18 and 25 and July 2, 1935.

No objections having been filed, it appears that the transfer can be made without injury to existing rights. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application for a change in point of diversion of water from Big Applegate River be and the same is hereby approved.
