On November 19, 1981, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Jack McEntire for approval of a change in place of use of water from Umatilla River under an existing right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of U.S. Reclamation Service, describes a right which includes the use of water from Umatilla River, for irrigation of 10.0 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 13, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1909.

These lands also have a supplemental right under Permit 7400 to the use of water stored in McKay Reservoir with a date of priority of July 1, 1924.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain 3.0 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 20, Township 4 North, Range 25 East, WM (Tim Tippott); 1.3 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and 0.7 acre in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, Township 5 North, Range 26 East, WM (Paul Hovinghoff); and 5.0 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 22, Township 5 North, Range 27 East, WM (Clarence Law).

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the West Extension Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting.

Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use of water, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1983.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the U.S. Reclamation Service, or their successor in interest.
