ORDER

The City of Medford is the holder of permit No. 23210 which grants the right to appropriate not to exceed 100.0 cubic feet per second of water from Rogue River for municipal use.

The City has advised the State Engineer that the appropriation has not been made as described in the permit, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development.

The City has further advised that the contract for the construction of the first phase of development has now been awarded.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant said extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limit to begin construction under permit No. 23210 be extended to October 1, 1970.
