## ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6146 submitted by

Hal Munson c/o Mr. and Mrs. Arnold Gross 240 W. Hersey Street Ashland, Oregon 97520

to use the waters of Ashland Creek, a tributary of Bear Creek, for the purpose of irrigating 0.442 acres.

The right to be transferred was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County as evidenced by certificate 16026. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1858.

This right is limited to 0.011 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 39 S, R 1 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.442 ACRE SECTION 4 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
- 2. The water user shall continue to maintain a headgate, an inline flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.
- 3. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

W 1/2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.442 ACRE SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

Certificate 16026 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
