ORDER

On February 22, 1972, Byron H. and Eva M. LaFollette submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW. THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the water right for the use of 1.88 cubic feet of water per second from Mission Lake with a date of priority of March 1, 1955, for the irrigation of:
