Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Applicant 1

Findings of Fact

- 1. On May 18, 2020, CAMERON BUCK filed an application for additional points of appropriation under Permit G-17077. The Department assigned the application number T-13445.
- 2. On October 16, 2013, the Department approved an assignment of the permit from CAMERON BUCK to WALTER C. BUCK, DAVID F. BUCK, AND NORTHWEST FARM CREDIT SERVICES, FLCA.
- 3. On November 1, 2019, the Department approved an extension of time for complete application of water to October 1, 2025.
- 4. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on June 2, 2020, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. On June 19, 2020, the Department contacted the applicant by written correspondence to notify the applicant and the applicant's agent of a deficiency in the application. The application was not signed by all holder of Permit G-17077, as is required by ORS 537.211(4). The Department requested that the deficiency be resolved by July 20, 2020.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 6. On June 26, 2020, the applicant's agent submitted Affidavits of Consent from a Deeded Landowner, signed by the other permit holders, granting consent to the permit amendment and resolving the deficiency.
- 7. Permit Amendment Application T-13445 proposes additional points of appropriation as follows:

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

- 8. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 9. The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 10. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

Conclusions of Law

The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13445 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13445 are approved.
- 2. Permit G-18727, in the name of WALTER C. BUCK, DAVID F. BUCK, AND NORTHWEST FARM CREDIT SERVICES, FLCA, is issued to replace Permit G-17077, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, the extension of time, and the assignment. Permit G-17077, in the name of WALTER C. BUCK, DAVID F. BUCK, AND NORTHWEST FARM CREDIT SERVICES, FLCA, is no longer of any force or effect.
- 3. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation (Wells 2 and 3), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation (Well 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well 1).

- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18727 remain the same.
