ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. W-113

On January 13, 1966, D. J. Mard filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Jeters of Deschutes River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of the Arnold Irrigation District for the irrigation of, among other lands, 8.1 acres in the SWA SWA and 23.5 acres in the SWA SWA, Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 12 Bast, M.M., tabulated in the name of J. Dorsch,; 1.5 acres in the NWA SWA, Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 12 Bast, W.M., tabulated in the name of O. L. Gray; and 12.5 acres in the NWA SWA, Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 12 Bast, W.M., tabulated in the name of J. Chase; all with dates of priority of February 1, 1905 and April 25, 1905. This right was confirmed by certificate recorded at rage 29053, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands also have a supplemental right under permit No. 23256 to the use of the water stored in Grane Prairie Reservoir, with a date of priority of February 28, 1915.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 25.4 acres in the NEW NEW and 20.0 acres in the NEW NEW, Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 12 Bast, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Armold Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water.

No objections having been filled and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 14.0 acres in the NEW SEW, 8.1 acres in the SEW SEW and 23.3 acres in the SEW SEW, Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W.M. with dates of priority of February 1, 1905 and April 25, 1905, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 25.4 acres in the NEW NEW and 20.0 acres in the NEW NEW and 20.0 acres in the NEW NEW & Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1966.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Arnold Irrigation District at the time certificate is issued to the District confirming other transfers within the District.
