ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6139 submitted by

to use the waters of a well in the Umatilla River Basin for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 35.6 acres.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 32593, was perfected under permit G-1854 with a date of priority of May 8, 1961. The right is limited to 0.13 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

Another right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 38740, was perfected under permit G-4748 with a date of priority of November 17, 1969. The right is limited to 0.32 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

These rights are limited to 0.45 CFS, if available at the Riley Well: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 6, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M., 170 feet North and 230 feet West from the southeast corner of Section 6.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 75 FEET NORTH AND 1285 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to an appropriation of water to make up any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land.

This right to use water is restricted to beneficial use on the lands as follows:



THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of appropriation.
3. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
5. When in the judgement of the Department it becomes necessary to install measuring devices, the pump system shall include and in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department before the beginning of construction work and the measuring device shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificates 32593 and 38740 are canceled. A new certificate will be issued confirming that portion of certificate 38740 NOT involved in this transfer. Upon receiving satisfactory proof that the change is completed, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
