ORDER

On September 11, 1984, M.L. Montgomery, as authorized by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife submitted an affidavit that the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 49276, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Summer Lake Irrigation District, and is for the use of not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second of water from Ana River, with a date of priority of October 11, 1915, for irrigation of 10.3 acres in Lot 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), 12.1 acres in Lot 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 7 and 18.1 acres in Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 18, Township 30 South, Range 17 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 49276, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
