**Findings of Fact**

1. On September 12, 2007, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-9724 from Wayne and Nancy Dollarhide.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-9724 in the name of Wayne O. and Nancy K. Dollarhide, on February 17, 2005. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 63, at Page 334. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2006.
3. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving an extension of time dated August 17, 2006. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 69, at Page 633. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2007.
4. The applicant has completed the installation of the pump with the approved fish screen. All mainlines and laterals with risers are in place. The water delivery system, Irripod, are approximately 10% assembled and in place.
5. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to complete the assembly of the water delivery system.
6. The landowner has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2008.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


**Conclusions of Law**

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-9724.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-9724 shall be extended to October 1, 2008.
