Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of diversion and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

1. On September 21, 2016, the Department issued an order approving Permit Amendment Application T-12335, recorded at Special Order Volume 101, Page 907-914. Permit S-55010 was issued to describe the changes approved under T-12335.
2. The Permit S-55010 contained a scrivener's error in the language describing the completion dates and is shown below:

Actual construction of the well was to begin within one year from permit issuance (June 7, 2012) and was to be completed on or before October 1, 2013. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 30, 2017.

3. The correcting language describing the completion dates is as follows:

The original permit was issued June 7, 2012. Actual construction work was to begin within one year of permit issuance and was to be completed within one year of commencement of construction. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2017.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:


1. Permit S-55019, in the name of Palmer Creek Water District Improvement Co., is issued to replace Permit S-55010, and incorporates the correction approved by this order. Permit

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

S-55010, in the name of Palmer Creek Water District Improvement Co., is no longer of any force or effect.

2. All other terms and conditions of Permit S-55019 remain the same.
3. All other terms and conditions of Special Order Volume 101, Page 907 remain the same.
