Transfer Application J-35, in the name of City of Jacksonville, proposed changes in use and place of use of water from Jackson Creek and Jacksonville Reservoir under certain rights with a priority date of October 6, 1910, from municipal use to supplemental irrigation of a certain 9.8 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 4.3 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 37.7 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 8.2 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 30, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM, and irrigation of 10.2 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 8.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 29.7 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 2.3 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 30.0 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, said Section 30.

The order of the State Engineer, predecessor of the Water Resources Director, entered February 21, 1963, approving Transfer Application J-35, provided: "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1964."

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order, therefore, the subject water right was lost.
