On February 23, 1968, Ruth E. Hall submitted affidevite that she is the owner of the lands and the water rights appurtenant thereto; that she has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water rights and request the same to be canceled.

The water rights in question were established by Decree of the Circuit Court for Klamath County entered February 5, 1930, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Sprague River and its Tributaries, as follow:

- (a) for the use of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre prior to June 15th, and one-eightieth of a cubic foot per second per acre after June 15th, with a total limitation of three acre feet per acre from Earch 1st to October 1st of each year, of the waters of South Fork Sprague River, through the Bly Extension Ditch, for irrigation of 10.0 acres in NE, 3E, 30.2 acres in NE, 3E, 18.5 acres in SW, SE, and 22.0 acres in SE, SE, Section 34, Township 36 South, Range 14 East, W.H., with a date of priority of 1900, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of Edward Bloomingcamp and recorded at page 9948, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates;
- (b) for the use of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre prior to June 15th, and one-eightieth of a cubic foot per second per acre after June 15th, with a total limitation of three acre feet per acre from March 1st to October 1st of each year of the waters of South Fork Sprague River, through Bly Extention Ditch, for supplemental irrigation of 10.0 acres in NET 40 acres in NET and 31.0

acres in SE, NEW (Tract No. 3), Section 34, Township 36 South, Range 14

Bast, W.M., with a date of priority of 1900, and is evidenced by certificate
of water right issued in the name of F. M. Hiller and recorded at page 9936,

Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates;

(c) for the use of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre prior to June 15th, and one-eightieth of a cubic foot per second per acre after June 15th, with a total limitation of three acre feet per acre from Earth 1st to October 1st of each year of the waters of South Fork Sprague River, through the Bly Extension Ditch, for domestic use and irrigation of 4.0 acres in NEW NEW, Section 2, Township 37 South, Range 14 Bast, N.M., with a date of priority of 1900, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of Walker-Woodruff Land & Livestock Company and recorded at page 10001, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

OPS 540.521 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under cath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby CRDERED that the right to the use of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre prior to June 15th, and one-eightieth of a cubic foot per second per acre after June 15th, with a total limitation of three acre feet per acre from March 1st to October 1st of each year of the waters of Bouth Fork Sprague River, through the Bly Extension Ditch, for irrigation of 10.0 acres in NET SET, 30.2 acres in NET SET, 13.5 acres in SET and 22.0 acres in SET, Section 34, Township 36 bouth, Range 14 East, W.I., with a date of priority of 1900, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 9945, Volume 9, State Record of Mater Right Certificates; for the supplemental irrigation of 10.0 acres in NET, 182, 40 acres in NET, 40 acres in SET, 40 acres in S
