ORDER APPROVING CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE
and POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7562 submitted by

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 53232, was perfected under Permit G-9074 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 9, 1980. The right allows the use of a WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 122.8 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.54 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 4, T 27 S, R 19 E, W.M.; 30 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET WEST from the CENTER, SECTION 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified was perfected under Permit G-7841 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 4, 1975. The right allows the use of a WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 3.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 2, T 25 S, R 17 E, W.M.; 100 FEET NORTH AND 630 FEET WEST from the SE CORNER, SECTION 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized places of use are as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

LOT 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 6, T 25 S, R 18 E, W.M.;
1290 FEET SOUTH AND 1250 FEET WEST from the NE CORNER,
SECTION 6.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The Department has received satisfactory proof that the right has been perfected in accordance with Permit G-7841.


THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999.

2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
5. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.

Certificate 53232 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
