O R D E R
EXTENDING TIME LIMITS

The City of Astoria is the holder of Permit No. 7257, which grants a right to the use of not to exceed 23.0 cubic feet per second of water from Young's River for municipal purposes.

The time for beginning of construction under the permit in question, as extended by the State Engineer, expired October 1, 1956.


The City of Astoria has advised the State Engineer that it has prepared plans and specifications for dams, pipelines, reservoirs and accessories for twelve million gallons per day of water supply costing approximately \$36,000. However, due to inability to finance and the high contract cost of such work at this time the appropriation described under this permit has not been made, but the City desires to preserve the right for this development.

It is considered by the State Engineer that the preservation of the right in question is consistent with the public interest, and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is HEREBY ORDERED that the time limits under permit No. 7257 be and the same hereby are extended as follows:

- April 9, 1963 for beginning of construction
- October 1, 1963 for completion of construction
- October 1, 1963 for complete application of water.
