Findings of Fact

- On July 15, 2020, CROOKED RIVER RANCH WATER CO. filed an application to change in place of use under Permit G-17670. The Department assigned the application number T-13490.
- 2. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on July 28, 2020, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5)! No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. Permit Amendment Application T-13490 proposes to change the place of use of the permit to:

QUASI MUNICIPAL		
CROOKED RIVER RANCH WATER COMPANY SERVICE AREA		

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

- 4. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 5. The proposed place of use is owned and/or controlled by the permit holder.
- 6. The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 7. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

8. The proposed place of use is contiguous to the authorized place of use.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13490 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13490 is approved.
- 2. Permit G-18478, is issued to replace Permit G-17670, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-17670 is no longer of any force or effect.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18478 remain the same.
