ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6294 submitted by

SALLY H. REYHER
6663 RIPPLING BROOK DR. S.E.
SALEM, OR 97301

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR, a tributary of the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.2 ACRES.

The rights to be transferred, as evidenced by certificates 55530 and 55531, were perfected under permits R-7712 and 43609 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 12, 1978. These rights are limited to the storage of 0.4 acre foot of water and 0.01 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 1/2 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.15 ACRE
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.05 ACRES
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificates 55530 and 55531, which allowed the storage and use of water for fish culture, are canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
