

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

- 6. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 7. The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 8. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

Conclusions of Law

The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13464 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13464 is approved.
- 2. Permit G-18475, in the name of Stafford Ranches/Sam Stafford, is issued to replace Permit G-13590, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, the extension of time, and the assignment. Permit G-13590, in the name of Stafford Ranches, is no longer of any force or effect.
- 3. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, (Well #2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, (Well #1).
- 4. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation, (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 6. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18475 the same.
