ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6292 submitted by

BURTON W. BLACKWELL
4622 LEONARD ROAD
GRANTS PASS, OR 97527

to use the waters of the Rogue River for the purpose of the irrigation of 2.3 acres.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 57598, was perfected under permit 1155 with a date of priority of April 12, 1912. The right is limited to 0.029 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the source.

The new point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 21, T 36 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1880 FEET NORTH AND 2170 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season.

This right to use water is restricted to beneficial use on the lands as follows:


NE 1/4 NW 1/4	1.5 acres
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	0.8 acre
SECTION 21	
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.	

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 57598 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right not involved in this transfer. Upon receiving satisfactory proof that the change is completed, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
