CORRECTION ORDER

Statements of Fact

1. The final order approving Transfer Application T-8853 was signed on May 4, 2004 and recorded at Special Order Volume 60, Page 28.
2. The order authorized a change in character of use, a change in place of use, and a change in point of appropriation for portions of Permit G-499 and G-1985.
3. Scrivener's errors were found in Conditions 4, 5, and 6 of the approval order.
4. The conditions with the errors are as follows:
 4. The use of water for nursery operations under Permit G-1985 on the 4.7 acres in the SE¼ NE¼ of Section 27 shall be limited to 0.12 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 23.5 acre feet per acre during the calendar year.
 5. The use of water for nursery operations under Permit G-1985 on the rest of the proposed place of use shall be limited to 0.07 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 13.5 acre feet per acre during the calendar year.
 6. The use of water for nursery operations under Permit G-499 shall be limited to 0.004 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 0.075 acre feet per acre during the calendar year.
5. The words "per acre" in Conditions 4 and 5 should be eliminated and the number "0.075" in Condition 6 should be replaced with "0.75".

Conclusion

The scrivener's errors found in the final order approving Transfer Application T-8853, approved on May 4, 2004, and recorded in Special Order Volume 60, Page 28, are corrected.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. Conditions 4, 5, and 6 in the order approving Transfer 8853, be corrected to read as follows:
 4. The use of water for nursery operations under Permit G-1985 on the 4.7 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27 shall be limited to 0.12 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 23.5 acre feet during the calendar year.
 5. The use of water for nursery operations under Permit G-1985 on the rest of the proposed place of use shall be limited to 0.07 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 13.5 acre feet during the calendar year.
 6. The use of water for nursery operations under Permit G-499 shall be limited to 0.004 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 0.75 acre feet per acre during the calendar year.
