ORDER

On March 8, 1968, Harley A. & Marian C. Piper submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of the following described lands:

Beginning on the north line of the Andrew Bowers D.L.C. No. 53 in Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., at a point which is 66.52 chains North 67° 05' West from the northeast corner of said claim; thence North 23° 23' East 16.27 chains; thence South 67° 05' East 40.22 chains to the center of the county road; thence South 29° 12' West along the center of said county road 7.90 chains; thence North 67° 05' West 8.911 chains; thence South 71° 12' West 12.64 chains to the north line of said claim; thence North 67° 05' West 21.06 chains to the place of beginning,

and the water right appurtenant thereto; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second of the waters of a well, tributary of Champoeg Creek, for irrigation of 8.8 acres in SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, 19.0 acres in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, 7.0 acres in NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, as projected within Barnabie D.L.C. No. 50, Section 26, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 8, 1958, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of Charles Newton Davis and recorded at page 30810, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

OKS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer, that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the right to the use of not to exceed 0.17 cubic foot per f cond of the waters of a well for irrigation of 8.8 acres in SEt NWt, 19.0 acres in NEt SWt, 7.0 acres in NWt SWt and 7.8 acres in NWL SE4, as projected within Barnabie D.L.C. No. 50, Section 26, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 8, 1958, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right recorded at page 30810, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a certificate be issued to Walter J. & Kathleen R. Wilmes covering that part of the water right not in question which is for the use of not to exceed 0.48 cubic foot per second of the waters of a well for irrigation of 0.4 acre in SE SE4, Section 2; and 0.5 acre in NW NE4, 1.5 acres in SWA NEA, 12.4 acres in NEA NAA, 29.2 acres in NWA NAA, 20.8 acres in SWA NAA, 29.0 acres in SE_4^2 NW_4^2 , Section 26; and 19.6 acres in NE_4^2 NE_4^2 and 5.8 acres in $\mathrm{SE}_{\overline{L}}^{\perp}$ Ne $\mathrm{L}_{\overline{L}}^{\perp}$, Section 27, all as projected within Barnabie D.L.C. No. 50, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 8, 1958.
