OF A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT) ORDER
IN THE NAMES OF E. A. AND J. O. HAYES)

On May 21, 1975, Joseph Pfau submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.


The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 50919, Volume 45, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of E. A. and J. O. Hayes, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second of water from Little Pudding River, with a date of priority of June 17, 1924, for irrigation of 0.70 acre in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 0.45 acre in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 1.80 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 8.30 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 50919, Volume 45, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
