Statements of Fact

- 1. The final order approving Transfer Application T-7346 was signed on March 25, 2004 and recorded at Special Order Volume 59, Page 453.
- 2. The order authorized a change in character of use and a change in place of use for two portions of Permit G-798.
- 3. Two scrivener's errors were found in the approval order.
- 4. The first error is located on Page 2 of the order within the paragraph:

The applicant proposes to raise the duty on the most northerly 0.37 acre portion of the proposed place of use of Certificate 80451. A 0.43 acre portion of Certificate 80451 will be transferred with a duty of 2.17 acre-feet per acre. The 0.43 acre will be reduced by 0.6 acre to bring the duty up to 2.5 acre-feet per acre. The rate for the 0.37 acre will remain the same as if it were 0.43 acre.

- 5. The third sentence describes a reduction in acres. The number "0.6" acre should be "0.06" acre.
- 6. The second error is located in Condition 2 of the approval order:
 - 2. The use of water for the proposed nursery operation shall be limited to 0.04 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 8.0 acre feet per acre during the calendar year.
- 7. The words "per acre" should be removed from the condition.

Conclusion

The scrivener's errors found in the final order approving Transfer Application T-7346, approved on March 25, 2004, and recorded in Special Order Volume 59, Page 453, are corrected.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The paragraph on Page 2 and Condition 2 in the order approving Transfer 7346, be corrected to read as follows:

The applicant proposes to raise the duty on the most northerly 0.37 acre portion of the proposed place of use of Certificate 80451. A 0.43 acre portion of Certificate 80451 will be transferred with a duty of 2.17 acre-feet per acre. The 0.43 acre will be reduced by 0.06 acre to bring the duty up to 2.5 acre-feet per acre. The rate for the 0.37 acre will remain the same as if it were 0.43 acre.

Condition 2. The use of water for the proposed nursery operation shall be limited to 0.04 cubic foot per second and shall not exceed 8.0 acre feet during the calendar year.
