ORS 537.348 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to lease an existing water right for instream purposes. OAR Chapter 690, Division 077 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating instream lease applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On May 21, 2007, the DRC and NUID, on behalf of several water right holders, filed an application to lease a portion of Certificates 72279 and 72283 to instream use. The Department assigned the application number IL-836.
- 2. On June 20, 2007, the Department issued an order approving this instream lease application, as evidenced by Special Order Volume 72, Page 430. Following issuance of this order a scrivener's error was identified in the description of the period during which water is to be protected instream. This order is being issued to correctly describe when water is being protected instream (see Finding of Fact #7) and supersedes Special Order Volume 72, Page 430.
- 3. The portion of the first right to be leased is as follows:

Certificate: 72279

Season of Use: April 1 to November 1 (by Decree)

Priority Date: February 28, 1913

Quantity: Rate: 5.19 Cubic Foot per Second (CFS) (proportioned rate)

Duty: 1238.48 Acre-Feet (AF)

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. - 5. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0077(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6). No comments were received.
- 6. Certificate 72279 includes the diversion of water from two storage facilities, Haystack Reservoir and Wickiup Reservoir, owned by the Bureau of Reclamation (BOR). Pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077 (2)(b), the BOR would need to be a co-lessor on any lease that includes the use of stored water from either of these reservoirs for instream use. The BOR is not a co-lessor to this lease. In Section 2.2 of the lease application, the source of water for the proposed lease is described as the Deschutes River. As the BOR is not a co-lessor on this lease, the lease of water under certificate 72279 shall be limited to live flow from the Deschutes River.
- 7. The lease application requests to protect water instream from May 21 through September 30. The lease application was received by the Department on May 21, 2007, and the earliest that the lease could be approved and any water protected instream is the later part of June. On June 21, 2007, Lessor #2 and the Lessee agreed to modify the lease application to adjust when water is to be protected instream. The instream use is as follows:

Deschutes River, tributary to the Columbia River

Instream Reach: From the Deschutes River POD (as described in Finding of Fact #2) to Lake Billy Chinook.

8. Other conditions to prevent injury and enlargement are:

Water leased instream under Certificate 72279 shall be limited to live flow from the Deschutes River.

9. If approved, this instream lease is not reasonably expected to significantly affect land use as prescribed by ORS 197.180, OAR Chapter 660, Divisions 30 and 31, and OAR Chapter 690, Division 5.

- 10. Based upon review of the application, comments received, information provided by the Department's Watermaster, and other available information, the Department finds that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the lease may be modified or revoked under OAR 690-077-0077 if the Department later finds that the lease is causing injury to any existing water right or enlargement of the original right.
- 11. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077-0070 or OAR 690-077-0075 a new injury review shall be required. Transfers will be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 and Division 077. Approval of this lease does not establish a precedent for approval of future leases or transfers.
- 12. The lease will terminate on November 30, 2007.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077. The lease conforms to the applicable provisions of OAR 690-077-0015.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. That the Lease as described herein is APPROVED.
- 2. The former place of use will no longer receive water as part of these rights, any supplemental rights, or any other layered water rights for irrigation use, including ground water registrations during the term of the lease.
- 3. The lease will terminate on November 30, 2007.
- 4. This correcting order supersedes Special Order Volume 72, Page 430.
