ORDER
APPROVING APPLICATION

On March 15, 1944, M. C. Rowden of Jacksonville, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Big Applegate River.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 5557, Vol. 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, was issued to Anna Mansfield confirming a right to the use of the waters of Big Applegate River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 16 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 22, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W. M., with a date of priority of March 25, 1918. The Fowler-Offenbacher Ditch is used for the purpose of conveying water for the irrigation of the above described lands, the point of diversion of said ditch being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The applicant herein proposes to convey the water for the irrigation of said land through the Fowler-Keeler or Kubli Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., was given in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in Jackson County, for a period of at least three weeks and not less than one publication each week, being the issues of June 1, 8, 15, 1944.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Big Applegate River, to wit: from the diversion point of the Fowler-Offenbacher Ditch being located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W. M., to the diversion point of the Fowler-Keeler or Kubli Ditch being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W. M., for the irrigation of 7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 16 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W. M., with a date of priority of March 25, 1918, be and the same hereby is approved.
