ORDER

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, on the applications of various districts and companies which were allowed inchoate water rights by the decree of the Court in the Hood River adjudication proceeding, and it appearing that the time as heretofore fixed for the completion of such rights expired October 1, 1935, and that said parties have not fully completed their inchoate rights although they have made reasonable efforts to reclaim their lands within the time allowed and have used due diligence in the prosecution of the work necessary therefor, considering the conditions which have existed as to agricultural development and litigation, and that good cause has been shown for an extension of said time;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the following named parties shall have until October 1, 1940, within which to complete their said rights:
