An affidavit was received from ROBERT S. and JULIE A. MOSSER, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 20792, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.023 cubic foot per second from A WELL, in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN. The date of priority is DECEMBER 12, 1945. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION OF 1.38 ACRES.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.38 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

More explicitly described as follows:

Lot 38, Riverview Addition, EXCEPT that portion laying easterly of Lambert Street; further EXCEPTING the west 50 feet of even width; EXCEPT: Beginning at an iron rod on the South line of Lot 38, Riverview Addition, which is 50 feet east of the Southwest Corner of said lot, thence east on said south line 100 feet; thence North 216.8 feet, more or less to an iron rod on the Southerly right-of-way of Old Dufur Road; thence Northwesterly along said right-of-way 106 feet to an iron rod; thence South 260 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 20792 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding and the Special Order entered May 14, 1976, at Volume 24, Page 164, also canceling a portion of said water right.
