O R D E R

Application has been made by Ed Dial for approval of a change in place of use of water from a three acre tract heretofore irrigated through OroDell Ditch which diverts water from the Grande Ronde River, which tract is described as follows:

Beginning at a point 39.3 rods South and 40.57 rods East of the Northwest Corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 38 East, W. M., running thence East 14 rods, thence South 34.5 rods, thence West 14 Rods and thence North 34.5 rods, to point of beginning.

It is proposed to transfer this right without loss of priority to a three acre tract belonging to J. C. McFarland, described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 50 rods West and 3 rods North of the Northeast Corner of Section 32, Township 2 south, Range 38 East, W. M., running thence North 34.5 rods, thence West 14 rods, thence South 34.5 rods, thence East 14 rods to the point of beginning, containing three acres and being situated within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 2 South, Range 38 East, W. M.

This latter tract is located above the OroDell Ditch and water would be furnished by pumping.

Section 5764, Oregon Laws, does not require that a notice be published in connection with the change in place of use of water. The OroDell Ditch Company was informed concerning the application and has advised the State Engineer that no objections would be presented and that such change would not be injurious to any of the other users of water from the OroDell Ditch.

The State Engineer being fully advised and it appearing that no such injury will result and that the water may be beneficially used on the tract upon which it is proposed to be transferred.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that said change in place of use as above described be and the same is hereby approved, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certificate of water right be issued to the said J.C. McFarland confirming his right to the use of water on the three acre tract above described and maintaining the priority of the right of the lands from which the water right is transferred.
