***Permit Amendment Review Criteria***

6. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
7. The proposed place of use is owned and/or controlled by the permit holder.
8. The change does not enlarge the permit.
9. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.
10. The proposed place of use is contiguous to the authorized place of use.

**Conclusions of Law**


The change in place of use proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12641 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The change in place of use proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12641 is approved.

2. Permit S-55172, in the name of Tierra Del Mar Water Co., c/o Owen Miller, is issued to replace Permit S-44592, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, and the extension of time. Permit S-44592, in the name of TIERRA DEL MAR WATER CO., is no longer of any force or effect.
3. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
4. All other terms and conditions of Permit S-55172 remain the same.
