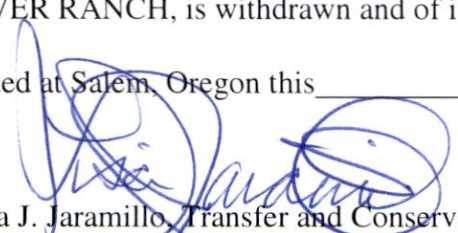
Findings of Fact
