ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6463 submitted by

ROBERT S. AND DIANA M. CRONHARDT 6955 EAST EVANS CREEK ROAD ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537.

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County as evidenced by Certificate 43976. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1902.

The right allows the use of EVANS CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 24.8 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.41 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion: $SE^{\frac{1}{4}}$ NE $^{\frac{1}{4}}$, SECTION 11, T 35 S, R 4 W. W.M.; VROMAN DITCH - 1200 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 11, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 15, T 35 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1140 FEET NORTH AND 810 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ 21.6 ACRES SE¼ SW¼ 3.2 ACRES SECTION 15

TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of diversion to:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 16, T 35 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 530 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the authorized point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 43976 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
