O R D E R

APPROVING APPLICATION

On February 23, 1953 Gale Merwin of West Salem, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Camp Creek, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O.C.L.A.

Certificate of water right issued to Walter A. Carson and recorded at page 968, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right under Permit No. 776 for the irrigation of 18 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 22 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 21 East, W. M., from Camp Creek, tributary of Crooked River, with a date of priority of October 24, 1911. These lands are irrigated through an unnamed ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located 750 feet north and 1970 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 1 and being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 21 East, W. M.

Gale Merwin, owner of the above described land to which said water right is appurtenant, proposes to change his point of diversion upstream approximately 1,000 feet to a point to be located 130 feet north and 2730 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 1, and being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 21 East, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O.C.L.A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on applications for a change in

point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile and where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. R. L. Schee, Watermaster of District No. 11, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Camp Creek may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Camp Creek may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Camp Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 750 feet north and 1970 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 1, and being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 21 East, W. M.,


To a point to be located 130 feet north and 2730 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 1, and being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 21 East, W. M.

for the irrigation of 18 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 22 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 21 East, W. M., with a date of priority of October 24, 1911, be and the same hereby is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work required to be done in connection with the proposed change in point of diversion of water shall be completed on or before October 1, 1954 or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
