On December 5, 1986, Joe Quinn and Jerry Jones submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 53613, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Herbert J. and Jacqueline M. Hester, Jerry Jones and Joe Quinn, Dry Canyon Farms and Dwayne Rosebrook, and is for the use of not to exceed 1.125 cubic feet per second of water from Well 8, with a date of priority of December 15, 1976, for supplemental irrigation of 39.2 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 17.1 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 33.7 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 20, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 53613, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
