ORDER

On August 27, 1982, C.W. Stutesman, authorized agent for the Community Methodist Church of John Day, Incorporated, submitted an affidavit that the Church is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the Church has abandoned any and all interest in anc to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 2898, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Frank E. Foster, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.004 cubic foot per second of water from Canyon Creek, with a date of priority of October 31, 1919, for irrigation of 0.3 acre in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 2898, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
