On September 19, 1984, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William Evan Gildow for approval of a change in place of use of water from Gales Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.250, proof has been made to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that a right has been perfected under the terms of Transfer 5343 in the name of William Evan Gildow, for the use of not to exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second of water from Gales Creek, for irrigation of 0.9 acre in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within Hardin DLC 60, 2.1 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 7; 2.3 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, and 15.1 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 8, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, with a date of priority of May 13, 1977.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 750 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 17, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the right therefrom to a certain 5.1 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Hardin DLC 60, 8.2 acres in Lot 2 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 17; 2.1 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Hardin DLC 60, and 5.0 acres in Lot 2 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM.

Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

 $N_0$  objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1986.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
