On April 17, 1998, Charles A. Bloodworth submitted an affidavit stating that he is the owner of certain lands and the water right appurtenant. The affidavit further states he has obtained a better source of water for primary irrigation of these lands and requests the water right be diminished from a right for primary irrigation to a right for supplemental irrigation of that portion.

The water right, a portion of which is to be diminished, is described by Certificate 51219, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The water right allows the use of not to exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second (cfs) of water from Well 1 and 3.50 cfs from Well 2, tributaries of the Columbia Basin, for the purpose of irrigation of 277.7 acres and supplemental irrigation of 35.0 acres. The date of priority is April 16, 1973

The portion of the right appurtenant to the property owned by Charles A. Bloodworth to be diminished is the right for the irrigation of 126.8 acres within the SW¼ of Section 30, Township 5 North, Range 29 East, W.M., namely:

NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ 32.0 ACRES NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ 32.0 ACRES SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ 31.4 ACRES SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ 31.4 ACRES

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of Certificate 51219 described above is diminished to supplemental use and a confirming certificate be issued to reflect the diminution.
