**Authority**

ORS 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

**Findings of Fact**

**Background**

1. On June 28, 2011, AUDRIC ENTERPRISES INC. filed an application for an additional point of appropriation under Permit G-16071. The Department assigned the application number T-11265.
2. The permit to be amended is as follows:
  - Permit:** G-16071 in the name of AUDRIC ENTERPRISES INC.
  - Use:** SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION ON 751.0 ACRES
  - Priority Date:** SEPTEMBER 8, 2005
  - Quantity:** 9.388 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND
  - Rate/Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
  - Period of Use:** MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31
  - Source:** A WELL within the LOST RIVER BASIN

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

3. Permit Amendment Application T-11265 proposes an additional point of appropriation located approximately 2330 feet from the existing point of appropriation:

41 S	11 E	WM	17	SE NW	WELL 2 - 1430 FEET NORTH AND 2430 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 17

4. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on July 5, 2011, and in the Herald and News newspaper on September 4, 11, and 18, 2011, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notices.

**Permit Amendment Review Criteria**

5. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
6. The change does not enlarge the permit.

7. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

**Conclusions of Law**

The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11265 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**


The change and subsequent use of water shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
2. Prior to water use from the proposed point of appropriation, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

3. Water shall only be acquired from the same basalt aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
4. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-16071 remain the same.
5. Permit G-16071, in the name of AUDRIC ENTERPRISES INC., is amended as described herein.
